Who can attend?

All boys 3rd grade through 12th grade and their RR Leaders. All camping equipment and food is to be provided by the outpost.

A background check and pastoral reference is required for all adult leaders.

Visitors

Visitors are allowed between 7:30am and 10:30pm. Visitors do NOT have to pre-register, but must check in/out at the camp office and wear the official camp visitor name tag on camp grounds.

Visitors are allowed to spectate, but may not participate in any of the activities.

Females are not allowed to camp overnight or participate in Summer Camp activities.

Camp Fees

All ages \$56/camper

\$15 per person late fee will be added for registrations after June 8. *Additional fees may be added by outposts to cover transportation and food costs.*

Pre-Camp Check List

- Sign up with Doris doris@wnmdag.org or 715-258-8118 to receive registration reports for your outpost.
- Camp registration and camp fees are collected online. Inform parents of additional food and transportation charges for your outpost.
- Hang camp posters & distribute flyers that refer parents to sign up online.
- List camp in church bulletin, ask for prayer.
- Monitor weekly registration reports and collect your outpost charges.
- Ensure adults 18+ turn in the Pastor Reference form before allowed on camp premises.

At-Camp Check List

- Turn in registration forms, medical release and payment for each camper & adult.
- Turn in Pastor Reference forms for each adult 18+.
- Sign up for meal guests, service patrol and security duties.
- Pick up your camp t-shirts and patches.
- Post schedule at campsite.

Duties of each Outpost

Event Helpers

All leaders are expected to help with camp events. We ask that each Outpost commit to meet at the altar before every evening service for prayer.

Meal guest sign-up

Take the opportunity to thank the summer camp staff by inviting them to a meal at your outpost.

A sign-up sheet will be posted at the registration table in the training center. Please sign up when registering.

Service Patrol

Rangers interested in being on the Service Patrol must be a Junior Training Camp (JTC) graduate and must be at camp no later than Thursday at 6:00 pm. Sign-up will be available at the Training Center.

Security Patrol

Two leaders are needed each night (Thurs – Sat.) from 11:00 pm to 12:30 am for night patrol. Please sign-up when registering.

Vehicles in camp

Vehicles may only enter through the main entrance and exit through the east gate by the dumpster.

All vehicles are to be out of camp by noon Friday unless prior arrangements are made with the Summer Camp Coordinator or District Director.

Vehicles will not be allowed in the campground until after the Sunday service is over.

No one under 18 may drive vehicles on camp property.

Parking of vehicles is allowed on Spencer Lake Road, but your vehicles must be parked in a diagonal manner at least three feet from the road to avoid being ticketed.

Lost & Found

Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. It is the camper's responsibility to check in the Training Center for lost items. We strongly discourage bringing sentimental items or anything of great value. Lost & found is kept for one month after camp.
