<p>Camp Registration:</p> <p>All Boys Camp Group Hold Application Outposts can have additional fees or 'scholarships' that are paid directly through Campwise registration. Complete & submit the form prior to registration period. The Outpost is provided a 'Group Hold' code.</p> <p>All Campers must register on-line. Parents must (electronically) sign Camp Forms; Campwise will not show the Early-Bird discount until check-out. Registration must be paid in full one month in advance to receive Early-Bird discount.</p> <p>All Adults must complete Camper Abuse Prevention Training (submitted every two years). Link to form is on the Camp webpage.</p> <p>All Adults staying overnight at Camp must have a Pastoral Reference Form submitted every year. Link to form is on the Camp webpage.</p> <p>Visitors allowed in camp 7:30 am - 10:00 pm. All visitors must check-in at the Reception Desk and wear a Visitor ID badge in Camp. NO visitors may stay overnight without a Pastor Reference form submitted to network office.</p> <p>All Ranger Leaders are expected to help with the Games & Activities; also, misc. duties at camp. Please have each Ranger Leader sign-up on the Activity sign-up list on the All Boys Camp webpage.</p> <p>Invite each boy personally to attend. Encourage the boys to invite their friends. Contact parents with camp information; including additional fees; and transportation details. Camp Check-in: [Thursday 3-5 pm; Friday am]
Front Reception Desk in Training Center. Sign up for Security duties; bathroom cleaning; and invite guests for meals. Pick-up your camp ID badges; T-shirts; and patches.
Check in medications at the First-Aid Station. All medications must be secured. Medications may NOT be stored in tents.
Security Patrol Two leaders are needed each night (Thurs-Sat) from 11:00 pm-12:30 am for the night patrol. Sign-up at the Front desk in the Training Center
Bathrooms There are no set times for showers. The 'small' bathroom is usually used by adults. Sign-up at Front desk in Training Center.
Invite guests to a meal in your Outpost. Take the opportunity to meet the Camp Staff or Guest Speaker by inviting them to a meal. Sign-up at the Front desk in the Training Center.
Vehicles in Camp All Vehicles must be out of camp by noon on Friday ; until after Sunday Service. Only Camp Staff may park in Camp Wilderness reserved parking area. (west of Ranger Theater). Vehicles may park adjacent to County Road EE; must be parked at least 3 ft from the road. Vehicles in violation may receive a citation.
Injuries , illnesses, or anything needing major medical attention must be reported to the First-Aid Station [Hinter Lodge].
Phone Charging Station Locks and Lockers are available to charge phones. Bring your charger. Boys are encouraged to NOT carry phones at camp.
Lost & Found Camp is not responsible for lost; 'stolen'; or broken personal items; especially electronics. Check in Training Center; if item has been found
All Campers must wear ID nametag in Camp.

Camp Games & Activities Outposts are asked to have distinctive Outpost insignia with items such as Outpost campsite entrance; costumes; Patrol Flags. Please review this year's Camp pamphlet for details.
