



Canoeing Adventure Camp PERSONAL EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

CLOTHING

- 1 hat (Royal Ranger or other)
- 1 Sweatshirt
- 1 Poncho (or raincoat with hood)
- 1 pr. Long pants, quick-dry (to be used as an emergency floatation device).
- 1 pr. Long pants (military-type fatigue; cargo; or other work-type trousers)
- 1 pr. Water Shoes (or shoes that can get wet). **[NO flip-flops]**
- 1 pr. Shoes for camp wear
- 1 pr. Shorts
- 1 Swimsuit (2nd swimsuit is optional)
- 3 T-shirts (Royal Rangers camp, etc.)
- 4 pr. Socks
- 4 Underclothing
- Sleeping gear (Pajamas or other)

Please bring your own life jacket to camp.
Bring a vest style, approved flotation device that fits well and is comfortable.
This will allow you enjoy your trip much more because you will be required to wear your life jacket anytime you are in the canoe.
Please contact your camp commander if you cannot get a jacket.
